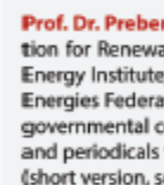

## Keynote Speakers



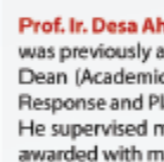
**Prof. Dr. N. El Bassam** is the director of the International Research Centre for Renewable Energy (IFEED), Germany, India and USA. Current focus of his research and engagement: Poverty Alleviation and escape prevention by creating autonomous habitats through intelligent endorsement of renewable energies in integrated energy settlements for improvement social, economic, environmental conditions as well as job creation, education, food and water supply. For this, he is an internationally recognized as poverty researcher. He is promoting the development of Concentrated Solar Thermal Power (CSP) in cooperation with German Aerospace Centre (DLR), and German Federal Ministry for the Environment, Berlin, serving in several committees, is EU adviser & Chairman of working group SREN, FAO, UNO. In this context, he worked out the UN-Concept of Integrated Energy Farms. El Bassam is the president of the "International Council for Sustainable Agriculture (ICSA), Chair of World Council of Renewable Energy (WCRE), member of editorial board of several scientific journals, author of numerous publications and books and received several awards.



**Prof. Dr. Preben Maegaard**, Danish renewable energy pioneer, author and expert, born 1935. Senior vice-president of EUROSOLAR, The European Association for Renewable Energy, 1991-2015; Founder and the first president of World Wind Energy Association (WWEA); the first president of the World Wind Energy Institute; Chairperson of the Committee of the World Council for Renewable Energy (WCRE); since 1998 board member of the European Renewable Energies Federation (EREF). Founder and director of the Nordic Folkecenter for Renewable Energy (1984-2013). Served on several Danish and international governmental committees and councils, wind turbine manufactures, universities and authorities. Author or co-author of numerous reports, books, articles and periodicals within the field of wind power, renewable energy, biomass for energy and sustainable development and has received a number of awards. **Dr. Ahmad Kushairi Din** is the Deputy Director-General (R&D) of the Malaysian Palm Oil Board (MPOB). He has a working experience of 36 years with MPOB. His field of expertise is oil palm breeding & selection. Other research interest includes biotechnology, agronomy, precision agriculture, farm mechanization, plant protection, peat research and sustainability. He authored and co-authored more than 200 publications. He is the President of The International Society for Oil Palm Breeders (ISOPB), consultant to several plantation companies in oil palm breeding and seed production. He is a member of the Pesticide Board, member of Plant Variety Protection Board, Academic Advisor to the Faculty of Plantation and Agrotechnology Universiti Teknologi MARA (UITM), and Council member of the International Institute of Plantation Management (IIPM). Dr. Kushairi is the Chairman of the National Technical Working Committee on the development of the Malaysian Standard MS2530 Malaysian Sustainable Palm Oil (MSPO).



**Prof. Ir. Desa Ahmad** is currently the Head of Smart Farming Technology Research Center (SFTRC) at the Faculty of Engineering, Universiti Putra Malaysia. He was previously appointed as a Director of the Centre for Agricultural and Food Mechanisation at Universiti Putra Malaysia and has also served as the Deputy Dean (Academic and Student affairs), Faculty of Engineering, Universiti Putra Malaysia. Currently he is coordinator for Master Programme of Emergency Response and Planning. His research area is mainly focussed on Soil-Machine Dynamics, Agricultural Machinery Engineering and Agricultural Mechanisation. He supervised more than 50 postgraduate students and has published more than 100 papers in distinguished international journals and he also has been awarded with many medals for the inventions he made.



**Prof. Dato' Dr. Mohd Yazid Abd Manap** is currently the Director of Halal Products Research Institute, Universiti Putra Malaysia and formerly the Dean of the Faculty of Food Science and Technology, Universiti Putra Malaysia. Due to his expertise in research, he is appointed since 2009 as a panelist for TECHNO FUND at Malaysian Agricultural Research and Development Institute, Ministry of Agriculture. Professionally, he was appointed as consultant for international food agencies including Italian Cheese Auditor and Nestle, Switzerland beside serving as a member in international and local food related associations. He awarded 10 golden medals for his distinguish inventions and has 6 patents and copy rights. Prof. Dato' Yazid is very active in publication and in total he published more than 150 papers in high quality international journals.



**Prof. Dr. Azni Idris** is the former Head of the Department of Chemical and Environmental Engineering, Faculty of Engineering, Universiti Putra Malaysia, UPM and currently working as a professor at the same Department. Since he has broad experience in green environmental technology, UPM appointed him as the Head of green technology and renewable energy research cluster. He was awarded many medals at the national and international exhibitions beside he has many patents. His area of interest includes water, wastewater, biomass and waste, biopolymer, green technology and renewable energy. He published more than 150 papers in international journals and supervised more than 15 Ph.D. students.
